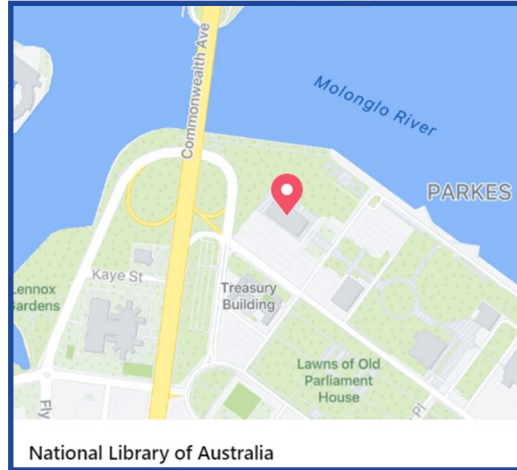

## How we conduct our group.

**FAW ACT & Region** plans and runs

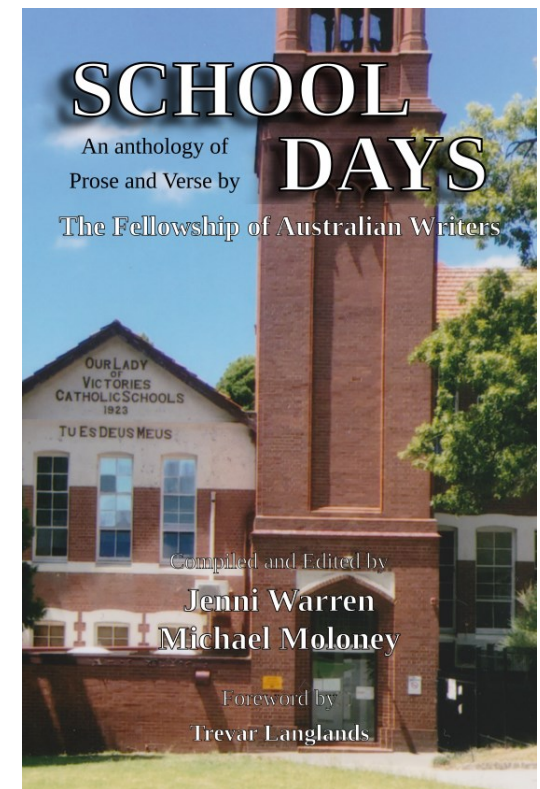
This activity promotes excellence in writing—an FAW goal.
